

NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR

Someone asked Jesus, "Lord, will only a few people be saved?" If you are one of those who is thinking not to be a part of the eternal banquet, read this "diamond story" about Dorothy Day told by a Catholic Worker staff:

A well-dressed woman visited the Worker house one day and gave Dorothy a diamond ring. Dorothy thanked the visitor, slipped the ring in her pocket, and later in the day gave it to an old woman who lived alone and often ate her meals at St. Joseph's. One of the staff protested to Dorothy that the ring could better have been sold at the Diamond Exchange and the money used to pay the woman's rent for a year. Dorothy replied that the woman had her dignity and could do as she liked with the ring. She could sell it for rent money or take a trip to the Bahamas. Or she could enjoy having a diamond ring on her hand just like the woman who had brought it to The Worker. "Do you suppose," Dorothy asked, "that God created diamonds only for the rich?"

Do you suppose that "salvation" is only for a few? I don't think so! Everyone is a diamond! We cannot be sold or exchanged for material things. You and I are like precious glittering diamonds in the eyes of God. Everyone has a unique space in the heart of a loving God. When we sin, he will not abandon us, but Christ will ransom us by his blood, and his mercy polishes us in order for us to shine like a diamond in his protective and loving hands. His grace of forgiveness always brings us hope and peace. The splendor of his healing is joy & love.

In our Eucharistic celebration today, as you come forward during communion time to receive Jesus, remember that the bread you will receive is the same Christ you see stretched out on the cross. He accompanies you to walk in the narrow door of heaven; he will lead you to the eternal banquet; and then invites you to "recline at the table in the kingdom" with him. Treasure then the company of Jesus... be a shining diamond Christian... and be an instrument of salvation for others...




